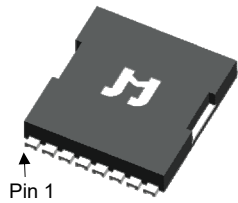

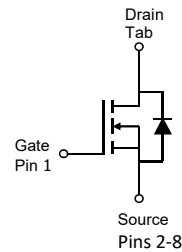
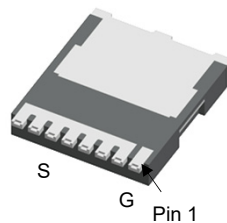

PowerJE<sup>®</sup>10x12 Bottom View



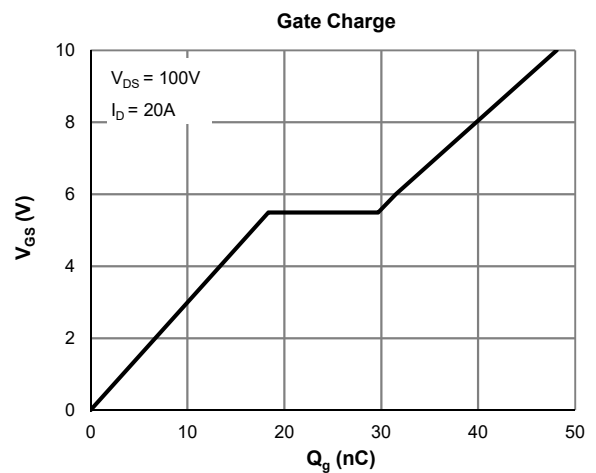
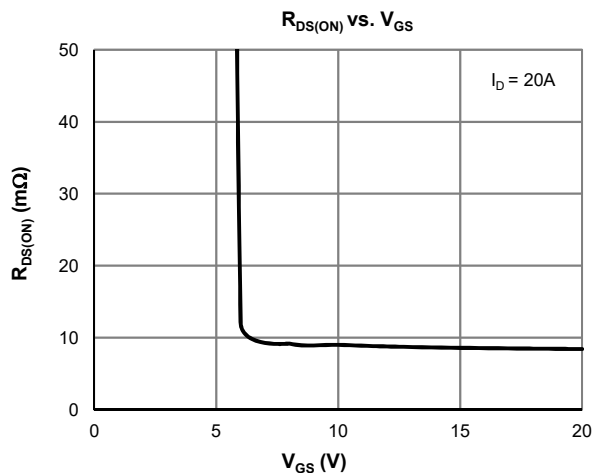

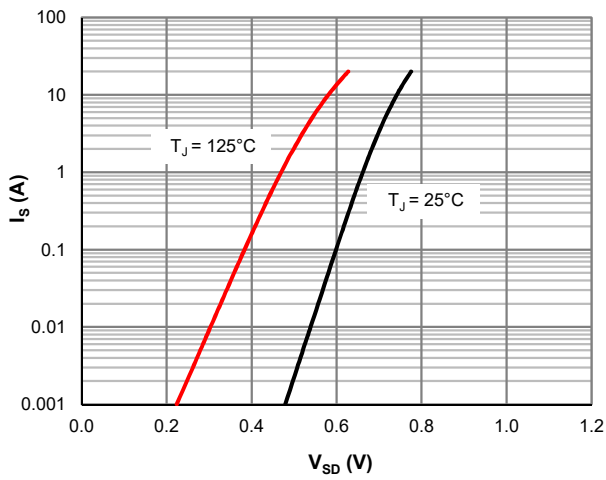

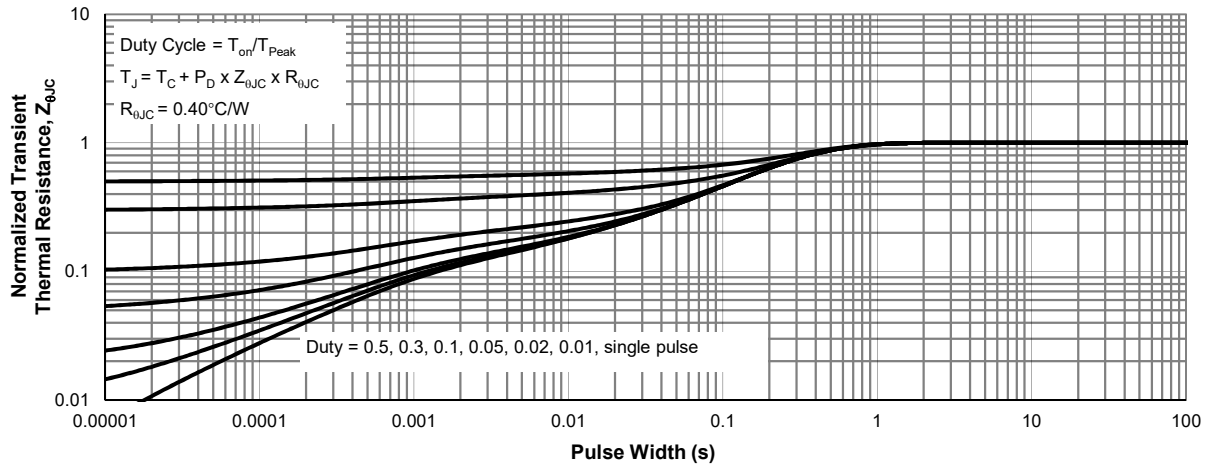
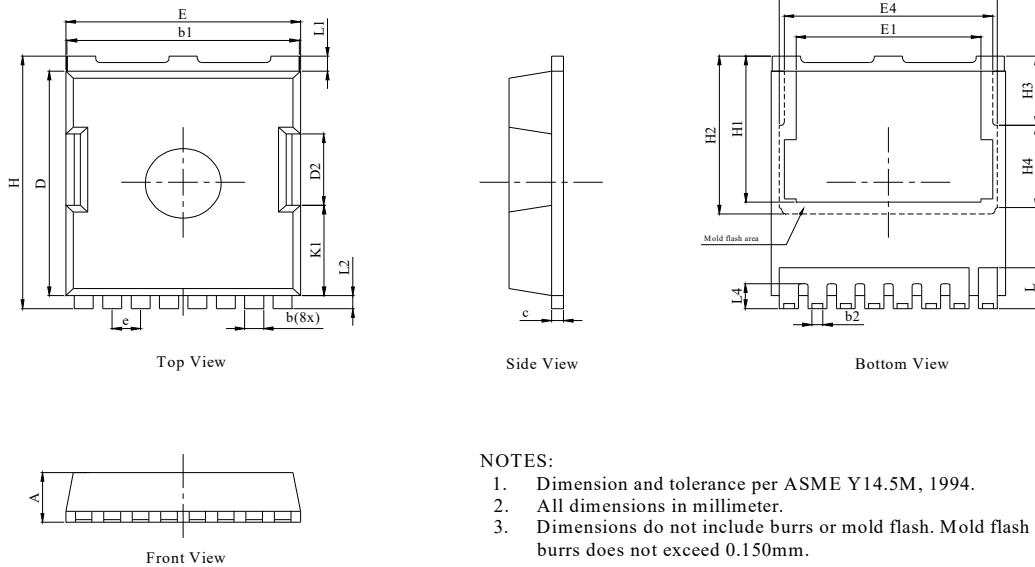


Figure 13: Normalized Maximum Transient Thermal Impedance
